Your privacy is important to NJTaxMaps.com so we've developed a Privacy Policy that covers how we collect, use, disclose, transfer and store your personal information. Please take a moment to familiarize yourself with our privacy practices and contact us if you have any questions.

Collection and Use of Personal Information

Personal information is data that can be used to identify or contact a single person.

How we use your personal information

- You may be asked to provide your personal information using forms on our website. These forms are used for NJTaxMaps.com to contact you and to provide support or assistance.
- We may also collect contact information and email addresses from various events. Customers who wish to receive information from us can supply their email address for marketing purposes—for example, a newsletter or to keep you posted on NJTaxMaps.com 's latest product announcements, software updates and upcoming events.
- From time to time, we may use your personal information to send important notices, such as communications about changes to our terms, conditions, and policies. Because this information is important to your interaction with NJTaxMaps.com, you may not opt out of receiving these communications.
- We may also use personal information for internal purposes such as auditing, data analysis, and research to improve View's products, services, and customer communications.

Website, Cookies and Other Technologies

NJTaxMaps.com's websites, online services, interactive applications, email messages, and advertisements may use "cookies" and other technologies such as pixel tags and web beacons. These technologies help us better understand user behavior, tell us which parts of our websites people have visited, and facilitate and measure the effectiveness of advertisements and web searches. We treat information collected by cookies and other technologies as non personal information. However, to the extent that Internet Protocol (IP) addresses or similar identifiers are considered personal information by local law, we also treat these identifiers as personal information. Similarly, to the extent that non-personal information is combined with personal information, we treat the combined information as personal information for the purposes of this Privacy Policy.

If you want to disable cookies, go to your browser preferences and then to the privacy pane to manage your preferences. On your mobile device, go to Settings, then specific browser you use, scroll down to the Privacy & Security section, and tap on "Block Cookies" to manage your preferences. For all browsers, check with your provider to find out how to

disable cookies. Please note that certain features of the NJTaxMaps.com website will not be available once cookies are disabled.

Protection of Personal Information

NJTaxMaps.com takes the security of your personal information very seriously. When your personal data is stored by NJTaxMaps.com, we use computer systems with limited access housed in facilities using physical security measures. Data is stored in encrypted form including when we utilize third-party storage.
